Presentation: At the outset, the Chair welcomed the members of the PSC and officials attended the meeting. After exchanging the pleasantries, he requested the Director General (DG)/Project Director (PD), URP: PCMU to present the agenda of the meeting. With the permission from the Chair, he categorically mentioned that the Annual Progress Report (July-June, 2019) of URP would be presented and discussed by the consulting firms for the approval of the PSC. At first, the DG/PCMU requested the Acting Team Leader (ATL) of GOPA (M&E consultants) to present the annual progress report. The ATL of the consulting firm presented the Annual Progress Report in Power Point.

In response, the representative of URP: DDM mentioned that they are waiting for the approval of the tenders for renovation works for the ERCC and NDRMTI. He further stated that the final decision would be taken by the Senior Secretary after returning from abroad. He also informed PSC participants that the Training, Drill and Exercise (TED) program will start very soon, if approval of the Phase 2 Program Implementation Plan and budget have the World Bank's concurrence and are approved by DDM/MoDRM. After detailed discussion, the Chair directed that PD, URP: DDM will take all necessary steps to get the approval of the tenders for renovation works for ERCC and NDRMTI, and to start Phase 2 of the TED Program with all urgency as it is critical to the URP's ultimate success.	will take all necessary actions to get the approval of the tenders for renovation works for the ERCC and NDRMTI, and to start Phase 2 of the TED Program as quickly as possible due to its essential contribution to achieving the URP's objective.
